## Rules & Regulations

- MeadowCreek Park, its show management, its employees, agents, staff or officers of any association will not be responsible for any loss or damage or injury to persons, horses or property. Each minor exhibitor must have parent, guardian or qualified instructor sign the release incorporated in the entry form. Each entrant is responsible for riding a properly conditioned horse in a safe manner. Management reserves the right to stop and eliminate unsafe riders or improperly conditioned horses. Management has the right to refuse any entry.
- Entries must be submitted online through Blue Horse Entries. Entries will only be considered complete when all entries, release forms and COVID-19 Protocol Agreements are signed and submitted online and full payment is received.
- Due to COVID 19 Protocols. There will be no spectators allowed and only two people may accompany a rider--Trainer, Groom or one Parent for a Minor. EVERY PERSON planning to attend must also sign the release form and COVID-19 Protocol Agreement before arriving. Wristbands for participants, coaches, grooms, and parents will be in the competitors packet.
- Entries that are eliminated during jumping phases for jumping penalties are required to leave the course and may not compete in any remaining jumping phase unless special permission granted by the TD. Schooling under the supervision of a qualified instructor will be allowed after the conclusion of the competition upon notifying management.
- Schooling the cross-country course on Friday will be permitted at no additional charge for horses entered in the CT. All others will pay standard schooling fees. Open schooling fees apply if NOT entered in show. You will NOT be required to go HC if you school on Friday.
- Properly fitting helmet with harness & boots with heels required whenever mounted. Jackets/stock ties are not required. Shirts must have sleeves and collar. Half chaps over paddock boots are permitted. Numbers must be worn and clearly visible when mounted.
- The competition will be conducted in accordance with the rules of the United States Eventing Association as described in the current Rules for Eventing.
- Dangerous Riding penalties may be assessed at any time during the competition as warranted. Ride smart, ride safe! Distances and speeds may be modified according to conditions Divisions may be split or combined as determined by entries.
- Ribbons will be awarded through sixth place. Divisions with sufficient entries may be split or combined at the discretion of the management.
- Entry fees are; \$65 for Combined Tests (dressage & stadium) PLUS grounds fees (This does not include stalls). Weekend stalls and tack stalls available for \$40, note coach/barn on entry NO outside shavings allowed. Shavings for sale on grounds, \$10/bag.
- NO motorized vehicles or ATVs allowed on course.
- All dogs MUST be on a leash.
- By entering the competition the competitor agrees to jump judge or otherwise assist with the competition. If you can't work it into your schedule please find a competent substitute to take your place. Your entry packet may be held until a volunteer is provided on your behalf.
- MeadowCreek Park recommends all riders join their local Eventing Association, as well as the USEA.

Preliminary	Open to Horse/Rider combinations who have completed at least 4 events at the Training Level.
Dressage	<a href="#">2018 USEF Preliminary Test A</a> (20m x 40m arena)
Stadium	10-12 jumping efforts 3 ft. 7 in. ~450 m @ 350 mpm

Training	Open to horse/rider combinations who have not completed more than 2 events at the Preliminary Level in the past 24 months
Dressage	<a href="#">2018 USEF Training Test A</a> (20m x 40m arena)
Stadium	8 - 12 jumping efforts at 3 ft. 3 in. ~ 450m @ 325 mpm

Novice	Open to horse/rider combinations who have not completed more than 2 horse trials at the Training Level or above in the past 24 months
Dressage	<a href="#">2018 USEF Novice Test A</a> (20m x 40m arena)
Stadium	10 jumping efforts over a course of ~450 m @ 320 mpm. Maximum obstacle height of 2 ft. 11 in.

Beginner Novice	Open to horse/rider combinations who have not completed more than 2 Novice events in the past 24 months.
Dressage	<a href="#">USEF Beginner Novice Test B</a> (20m x 40m arena)
Stadium	8 - 10 jumping efforts over a course of ~350 meters @ 300 mpm. Maximum obstacle height of 2ft. 6 in.

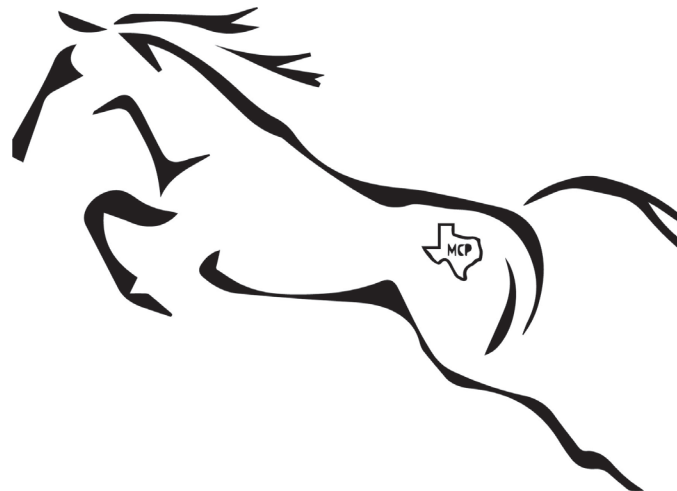

## Divisions:

\*Speed faults and time penalties will be addressed for GL and Gag\*

Goldilocks (Starter)	Open to horse/rider combinations who have not completed more than 2 Beginner Novice events in the past 24 months.
Dressage	<a href="#">2018 USEF Beginner Novice Test A</a> Test may be called.
Stadium	8 to 10 jumping efforts over a course of ~300 meters (no time penalties). Maximum obstacle height of 2'3" no combinations, inviting first fence.

Green As Grass	Open to horses that have not competed above the Beginner level or riders who have not competed Beginner or above
Dressage	<a href="#">USDF 2015 Introductory Test A</a> Test may be called.
Stadium	8-10 jumping efforts over a course ~300 m/m Maximum obstacle height of 2ft., mostly cross rails. Not Timed
